

The Washington State Fair is pleased to offer young artists from the Northwest an opportunity to showcase their best work for the Korum Art Competition. Students, *grades 11-12 during the 2022-2023 school year* are invited to participate in what many consider to be the area's most prestigious show for the artistic community's younger generation.

DATES TO REMEMBER

- Monday, January 16 Online registration opens
- **Monday, April 3** Online entry registration closes at 10pm.
- Thursday, April 6 Mailed in Korum artwork must be received by The Fair no later than 4pm.
- Walk in delivery of all registerd artwork;
 April 7, 2pm 7pm or April 8, 11am 6pm
 Walk in through the Red Gate off of 9th Ave SW to The Fair Food Court to deliver your art.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

- All work must be done exclusively by the student entrant, grades 11 and 12 only, within the current school year.
- There is **no fee** to enter
- ONE ENTRY PER STUDENT Entries are limited to one per student. Students who submit multiple pieces will have one piece selected, at the discretion of The Fair, and all other pieces will be rejected.
- Register entries online and return the scholarship form.
 We cannot guarantee against spelling errors. Please type carefully and use proper case for names and titles when registering entries online.
- All work must be titled! "Untitled" is not allowed as a title
 in the show. Untitled work will be retitled under the
 discretion of the Fair or rejected at check -in. We
 encourage that titles should be unique and short.
- We ask that all artwork is no larger than 20" x 20" and must be framed.
- The Fair reserves the right to reject any work it finds objectionable.

JUDGING

Artwork will be evaluated and judged on the following criteria:

- originality
- creativity
- composition
- design
- technical
- · craftsmanship

AWARDS

Scholarships will be awarded to the top three finishers in the competition: first place \$2,500, second place \$1,500, third place \$1,000. The winning piece (1st place) will be retained by the Foundation and auctioned at the annual Washington State Fair Foundation Round Up Auction, it will not be returned to the student. All Auction proceeds from the sale of the winning art piece will be used to fund the Washington State Fair Foundation Scholarship program.

Korum artwork that was submitted by mail will be returned by mail if the artist'a mailing address is further than 35 miles from the fairgrounds. Return postage will be paid courtesy of The Washington State Fair Foundation.

The Washington State Fair is not responsible for artwork that is lost or damaged in the mail.

Artists who live within 35 miles of the fairgrounds will be required to pick up their artwork on either April 28, 12-8pm or April 29, 11am-3pm. Enter through the Gold Gate off of 9th Ave and Meridian. Walk in and follow the directional signs to The Gallery at the west end of Showplex.

2023 Scholarship Summary KORUM FAMILY ARTS SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

The Washington State Fair Foundation is pleased to present scholarship opportunities to students for continuing education. Scholarship awards are made possible through the generosity of the Foundation's donors and Board of Directors.

Scholarship Description:

The Korum Family Arts Scholarship Competition is intended to promote appreciation for the arts, to encourage young artists in the pursuit of their artistic and educational growth and to showcase the uniqueness of Washington State. Scholarships will be awarded to the top three finishers in the competition: first place \$2,500; second place \$1,500; third place \$1,000. Recipients must use the scholarship in order to attend a college or university of his or her choice. Monies will be forwarded directly to the recipient's educational institution and must be utilized within 24 calendar months of the date of its award; thereafter it is forfeited. **The winning piece (1st place)** will be retained by the Foundation and auctioned at the annual Washington State Fair Foundation Round Up Auction; it will not be returned to the student. All proceeds from the sale of the winning art piece will fund the Washington State Fair Foundation scholarship program.

Criteria:

This is a special competition within the Washington State Fair Junior/Senior High School Art Show; please refer to the 2023 guidelines and entry information available online in early 2023.

- o Entries should showcase the uniqueness of Washington State ie: share what makes Washington special to you
- o Scholarship competition is open to any eligible high school junior or senior (2022-2023 school year)

Process:

- Please follow online entry registration instructions on page 3 for the Washington State Fair Junior/Senior High School Art Show and select "Korum Family Arts Scholarship Competition."
- All entries in the scholarship competition require a secondary release form (pg. 5) allowing the Foundation to retain ownership of the winning piece. **Entries submitted without the release form may be disqualified.**
- Entries will be judged on creativity, composition, and technique, as well as how effectively the entry celebrates the uniqueness of Washington State.
- By submitting the artwork, the student agrees that Korum for Kids Foundation and Washington State Fair Foundation are granted reproduction rights.
- Upon award, the recipients are required to complete an Award Form and submit it along with a JPG photo and photo release, and brief personal biography (required forms will be provided to 1st-3rd place finishers).
- Award monies will be held for distribution to college or university and are forfeited if not utilized within 24 months of the award date.
