◆ **Lake Stickney Elementary:**

The new school was completed in time for the opening of the new school year. Students, parents, and staff members are enjoying the new facility, especially the natural lighting in classrooms.

◆ **Kindergarden Center:**

The construction of the new school started during the summer. Located behind Fairmount Elementary on Beverly Park Road, when the school opens a year from now, it will be a happy place full of young kindergarteners.

◆ **Olympic View Middle School:**

If you have driven past the school on the Mukilteo Speedway, you may have noticed that the old gymnasium building is gone. It was demolished during the summer and will be replaced by a new building that will house a new gymnasium as well as other physical education facilities, the
