## Construction projects set to be finished this summer.

**T**hree of the larger construction projects approved by voters three years ago are nearing completion. The new Pathfinder Kindergarten Center, the modernization of the gym building at Olympic View Middle School, and the new multi-purpose room and kitchen at Discovery Elementary will be ready for students when school starts in September.

The completion of Pathfinder is especially noteworthy because it will allow the school district to finally offer full-day kindergarden sessions for all students of that age throughout the school district.

Beginning next fall, students from several elementary schools will attend Pathfinder, which will provide classroom space for about 550 kindergarden students. Other kindergardeners will attend full-day sessions at their neighborhood elementary schools.

As for the school itself, it was designed specifically to take into account current research on the design of learning spaces for young children.

Meanwhile, construction will soon be completed on a new gymnasium building at Olympic View that also will provide a cardio/weight room, locker rooms, and five classrooms, as well as a new auxiliary gym and a new main gym that will include bleacher seating for 850 people.

The new facility also will include a band room, choir room, rehearsal rooms, instrument and uniform storage and a music library for the school's music program.

The improvements at Discovery Elementary will provide the school with a new multi-purpose room and kitchen.

## SPRING MUSICALS:

With the arrival of spring comes the season of musicals in Mukilteo high schools. This year, the students at Mariner will perform *The Wiz* while the students from Kamiak will present *Footloose*.

Mariner's production of *The Wiz*, a musical written by William F. Brown with music and lyrics by Charlie Smalls, gets underway immediately with performances at 7 p.m. on March 23, 24, 25, 30, 31, and April 1 in the Mariner Little Theatre.

Tickets will be available at the door and Gold Team cards will be accepted at all performances. The regular price for tickets is \$10 for adults and \$5 for students and senior citizens.

The drama students at Kamiak will present the musical *Footloose*, which tells the story of Ren and his mother who move from Chicago to a small farming town where a local edict bans dancing.

The show will be presented in the Kamiak Performing Arts Center. Gold Team members are welcome to enjoy a free preview performance at 7 p.m. on Thursday, May 4. All seats for that performance will be first-come, first-served general admission.

Gold Team members also can use their membership cards to attend the 7 p.m. performances on Friday, May 5 and Saturday, May 6, or the matinee performance at 2 p.m. on Saturday, May 13. You can also attend other performances at 7 p.m. on Friday, May 12 or Saturday, May 13, but free Gold Team will not be available for those performances. You can still receive the discounted senior rate, however.
