## Kamiak winter play will be Radium Girls.

The Kamiak drama students will give four performances of the play *Radium Girls* as their winter drama production. Performances will be held at 7 p.m. on January 10, 11, 12, 18, and 19 in the Kamiak Performing Arts Center.

In 1926, radium was a miracle cure and luminous watches the latest rage—until the girls who painted them began to fall ill with a mysterious disease.

Inspired by a true story, *Radium Girls* traces the efforts of Grace Fryer, a dial painter, as she fights for her day in court. Her chief adversary is her former employer, Arthur Roeder, an idealistic man who cannot bring himself to believe that the same element that shrinks tumors could have anything to do with the rash of illnesses among his employees.

Written by D.W. Gregory, *Radium Girls* offers a wry look at the peculiar American obsessions with health, wealth, and the commercialization of science.
