Desktop Computer Log in and Qmlativ Access

When you first log into your computer, your login will be your student ID number and your password will be Pwmmddyyyy. (After the Pw it is your birthday. Log in example: Pw09042015).

You will be prompted to change your password from here.

Logging into the computer requires a password that has the following criteria:

- 10 characters in length as a minimum
- Must contain uppercase letters
- Must contain lowercase letters
- Must have a number OR a character
- Cannot be your name or a proper noun

Examples: Skateboard24 Football14 Passwordsare\$illy9 Reader4ever #Computersrfun

Should you get locked out of your computer, or Qmlativ, please contact your classroom teacher or the library staff to assist you.

You are able to access the Library Catalog and Qmlativ remotely from your home computer. You are able to access your computer files if you have saved your documents into your Google Drive or Office 365 One Drive.

Additional Technology Tidbits

Outlook and Schoology

You have the ability to email through Outlook and message in Schoology. You might want to make a habit to check your Outlook and Schoology frequently, so you do not miss key events and deadlines.

Paper Cut

You have the ability to print 60 pages per month from your school computer. Please print wisely. If your computer is not printing, then chances are that you are out of copies. You can log onto Paper Cut to check the availability of your account using your computer log in and password. Contact the library staff if you are in a sticky wicket.

Sno-Isle Library Card

It is highly recommended that you get your own Sno-Isle Library Card. The on-line resources for database and research are a gold mine for you! In addition, you can also download a bevy of resources as well as placing books on hold to pick up at the Sno-Isle Library Mariner Branch. See library staff for an application. This service is free!

On-Line Citations

It is highly recommended that you use **NoodleTools** to keep track of your on-line citations and giving credit to your sources. You can access this fine tool through your Google Drive.

Safari Montage

Safari Montage is a great way to look at a wide variety of multi-media for a specific subject area. You can log onto this with your computer log in username and password to access this program from school or home.
