At the end of each trimester, students will attend an assembly where they'll celebrate the accomplishments of their peers and themselves. These assemblies are upgraded from our past Accelerated Reader Awards Assemblies. Now, all students have access to awards according to appropriate goals. Each assembly will have three parts: a) Cougars C.A.R.E awards, b) performance opportunities for students who are confident in a skill, and c) a Confident Cougars Power Point of classrooms and individual students highlighting what they do well or what they are learning. Each grade level team has selected criteria for the Cougars C.A.R.E awards. The awards are aligned and graduated in difficulty as students mature. For example, kindergarteners who have demonstrated exemplary performance in either Compassion, Academics, Respect, or Extra-ordinary Effort may be recognized at the assembly whereas fifth graders may be recognized for outstanding leadership in all four of the C.A.R.E. components. For your clarification, a rubric is attached containing achievement levels of expectations for each component of Cougars C.A.R.E. At the October 4th PTA meeting, I plan to present more information, gather your input, and answer questions regarding our plan and rationale for our school celebrations' plan.
