Dear Mukilteo School District families,

Wednesdays are school days

Just a reminder that on Wednesdays, students should still log on to Schoology and engage in independent learning and assignments. Logging into Schoology is one way teachers take attendance, which they do every weekday. Elementary students will still have a Wednesday check-in with their teachers in addition to the independent (asynchronous) learning for the day. Individual middle and high school students will receive additional support from their teachers as needed.

What is an absence during distance learning?

A student will be marked absent for the day if they miss 50 percent of the day's classes. For a middle and high school student, that would be two out of three classes in a day.

How do I report or excuse an absence?

Let your school office know of your child's absence like you would during a typical school year. The office staff will let teachers know about excused student absences.

Attendance is so critical to students' educational success that there is a whole month set aside to raise awareness about it. September is School Attendance Awareness Month. Please encourage your child to engage every school day.
